
BZ Life TEAM ACCOUNTABILITY CHECKLIST

“As iron sharpens iron, one man sharpens another.”

Proverbs 27:17, NLT

TEAM CAPTAIN:

Open with prayer. Ask the questions and have each man answer them before moving on to the next question. Prompt and PRESS the men to be specific with his answers. To expedite the process have each man choose five questions they want you to ask them each week. These should be based on their challenges. Note: Question six and seven should always be asked. Close with prayer and prayer requests.

1. In what ways have you sought the Bible for real life decisions/challenges? 2 Timothy 3:16
 2. How have you demonstrated your covenant with your eyes and thoughts, as is relates to inappropriate TV, Computer, etc.? Job 31:1
 3. What Level of Confession did you reach with God this week? (0-mistake, I-general, II-surface, III-specific, IV-deep repentance) Proverbs 28:13
 4. How did you spend adequate time with your family? connecting physically (time, touch & play), emotionally (listening, connecting & coaching)and spiritually (prayer, discipling & loving)? Colossians 3:19 & 21
 5. In what ways did you GET REAL and/or struggle with wearing a MASK—Manufacture an identity? 1 John 1:7 OR---How have you shaded the truth this week to make yourself look better to others?
 6. Describe your personal devotions (Bible study/worship/prayer) last week with the lens of relationship. 1 Timothy 4:7b-8
 7. What did you do to live the Bible and how did you invite God into your week? Joshua 1:8
 8. What did you do to avoid your personal areas of temptation? Mark 14:38
 9. When did you confess your sins to a TRUSTED Man? James 5:16
 10. Did you “USE” substances in an abusive way? (alcohol, tobacco, etc) Ephesians 5:18
 11. How have you shared Christ in word or in action? Matthew 28:19-20
 12. What did you do this week to take care of your body (exercise, diet, and rest)? 1 Corinthians 6:19
 13. How did you manage your ANGER? Proverbs 29:11
 14. What steps or decisions did you make with God’s money? 1 Timothy 6:10-12
 15. Have you deleted or edited out anything that prevents you from GETTING REAL?
